The Wichita Wizards welcome PC Patton as the organization’s new Head Coach, as the team prepares for its next chapter of Wizards basketball and continued growth in the Wichita community.

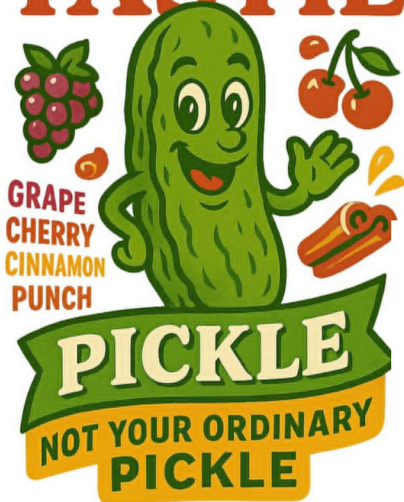

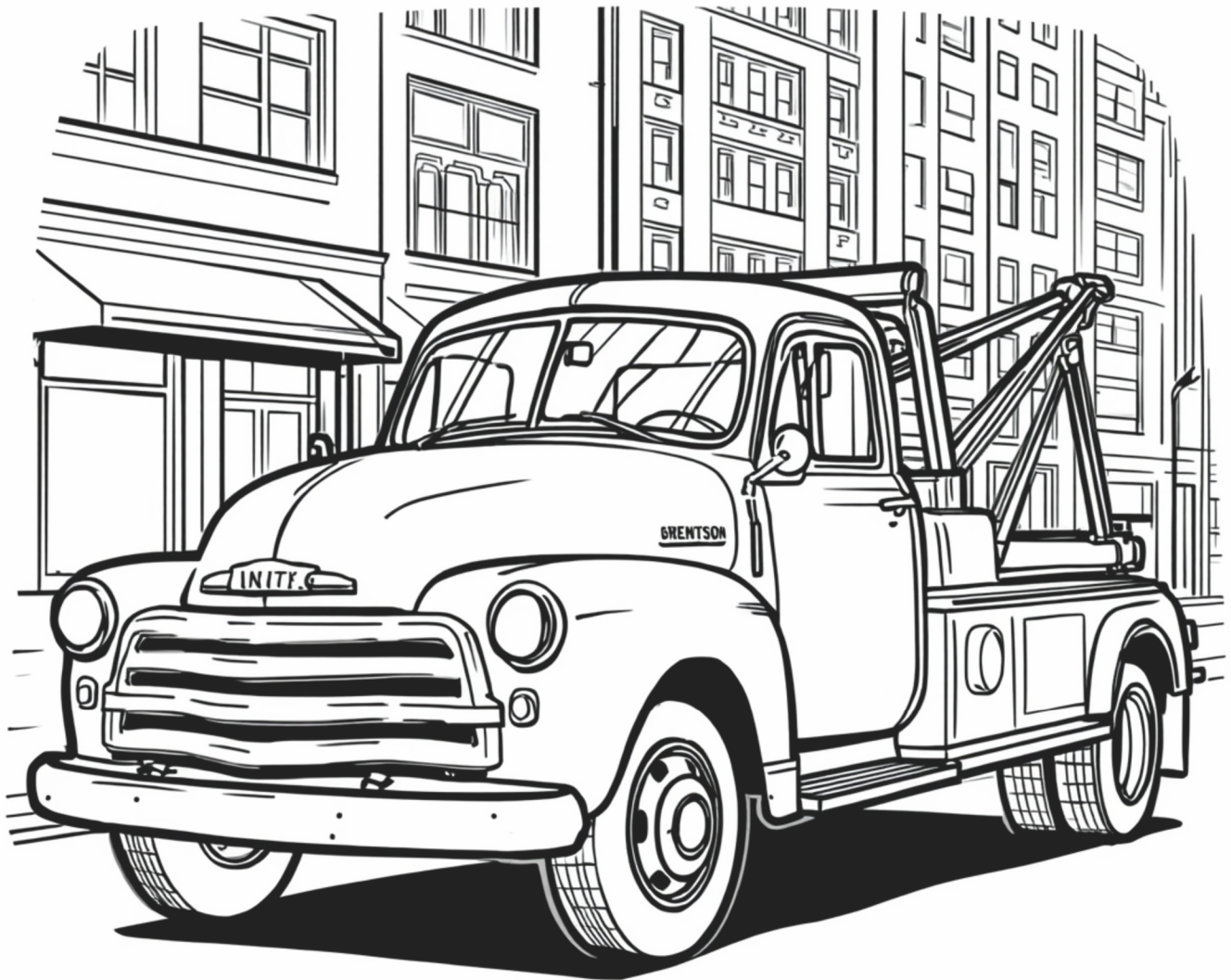
